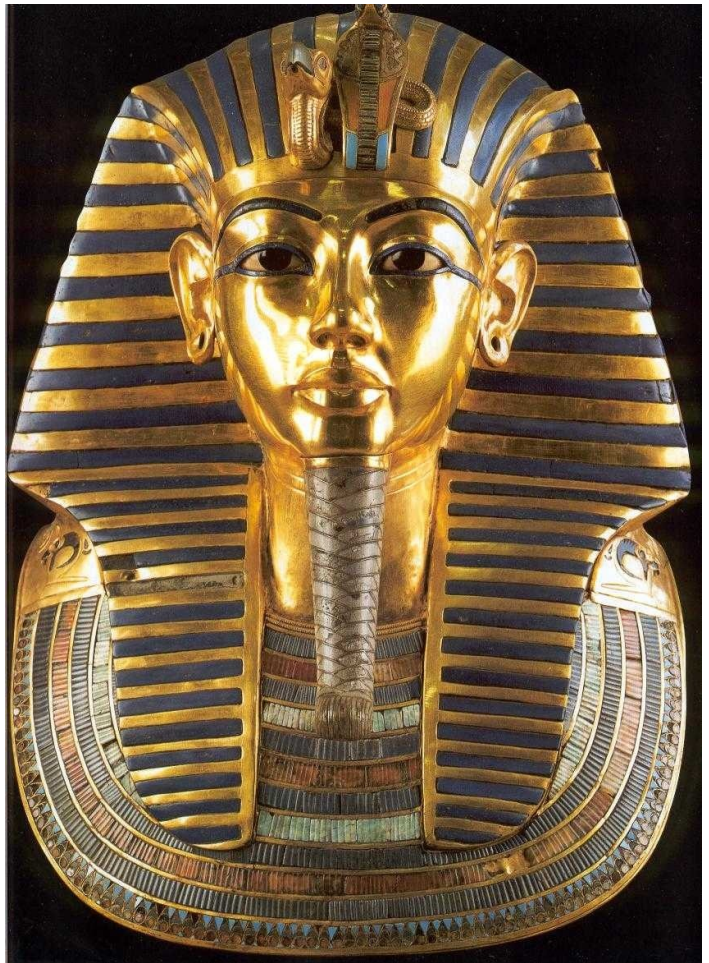

Gold & inlaid glass and gemstones, 54×39.3×49cm, Egyptian Museum, Cairo

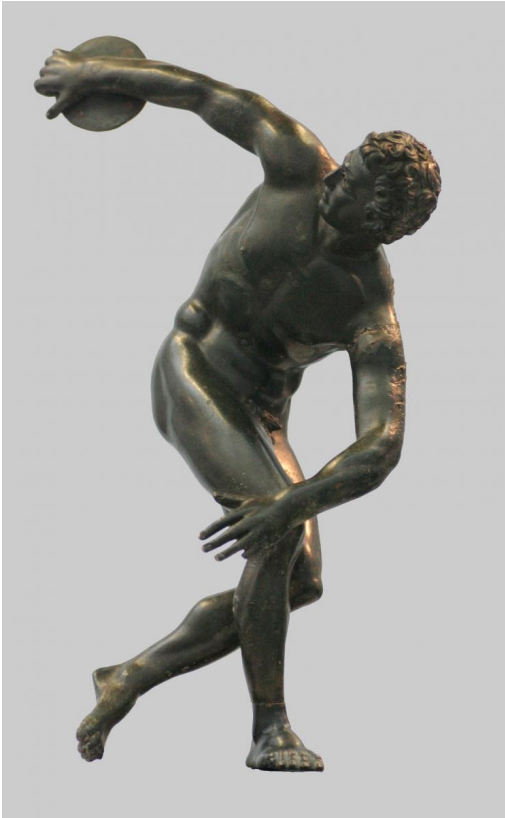


Unknown, **The Terracotta Army**, 210-209 BC
Life-size terracotta, Mausoleum of the First Qin Emperor, China



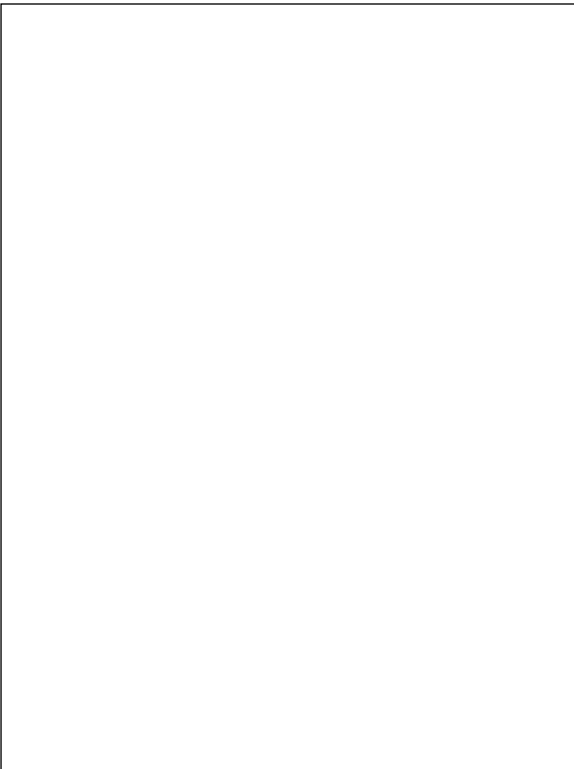
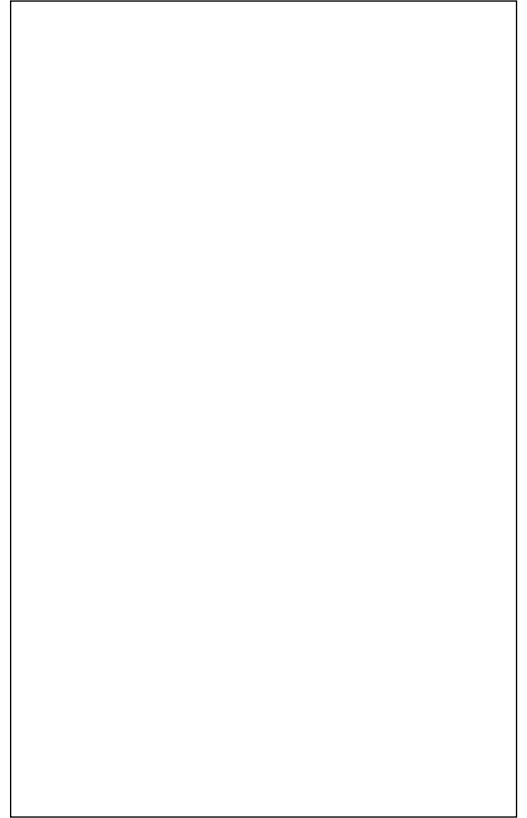

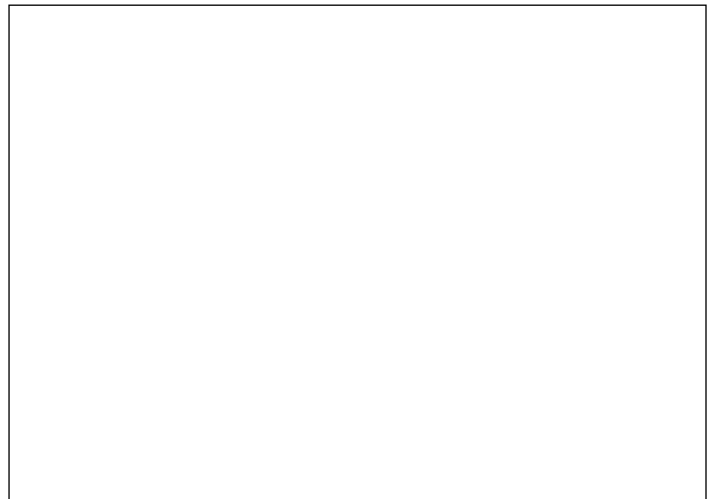

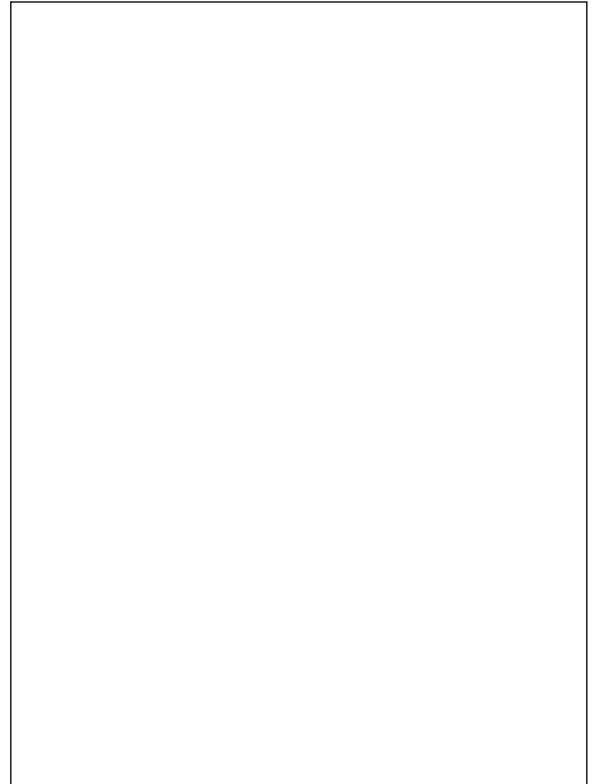

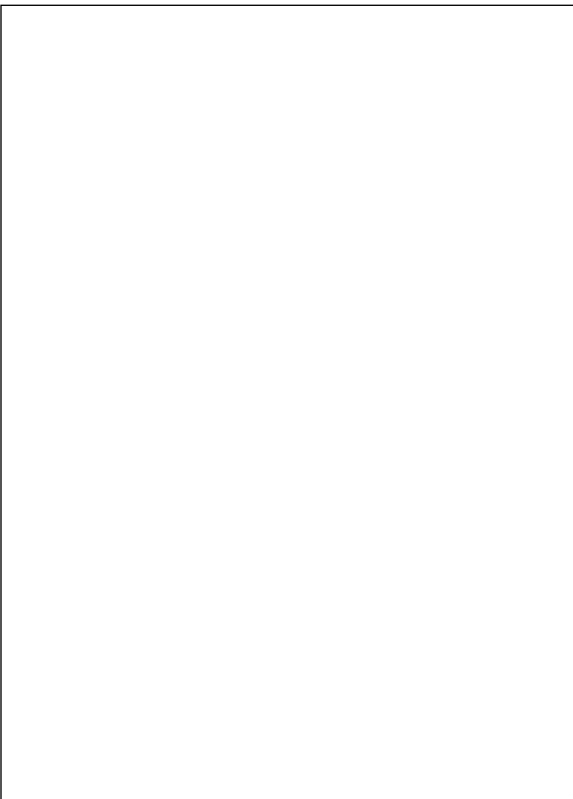

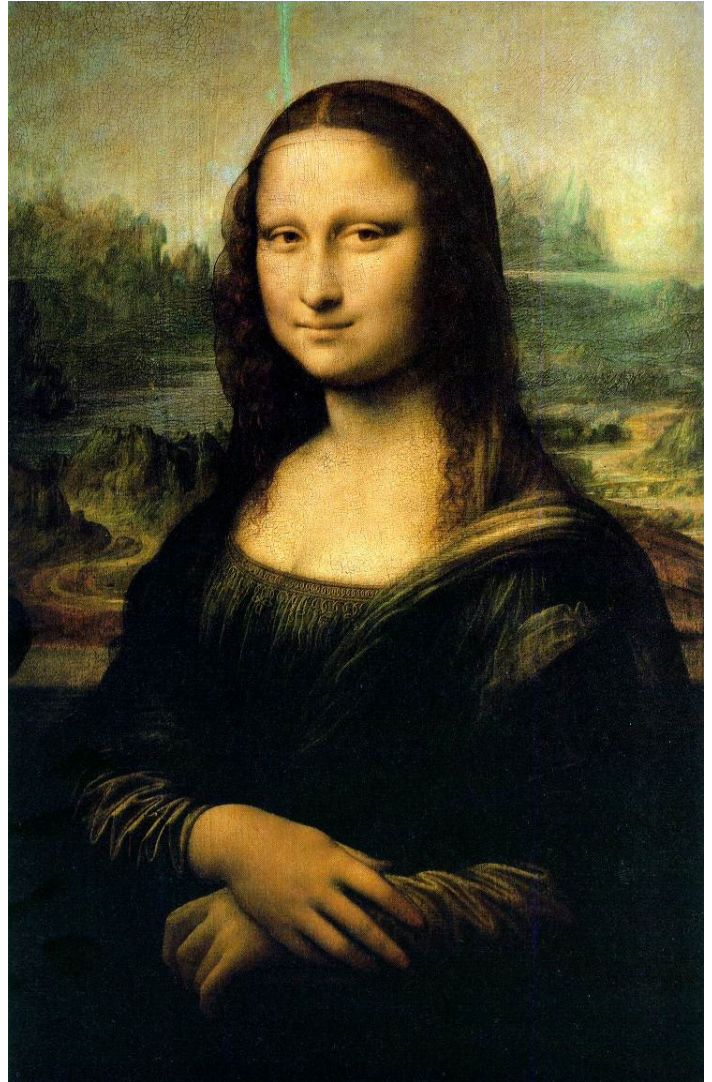

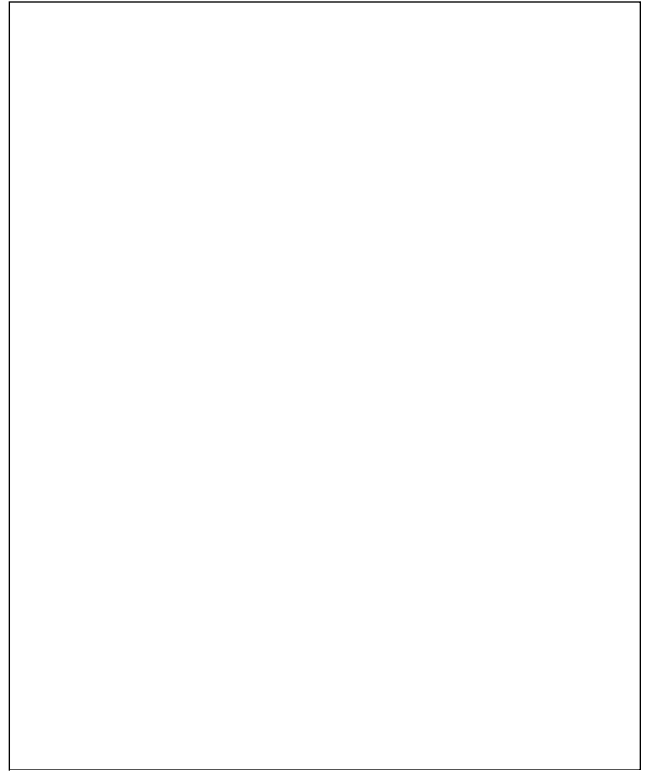

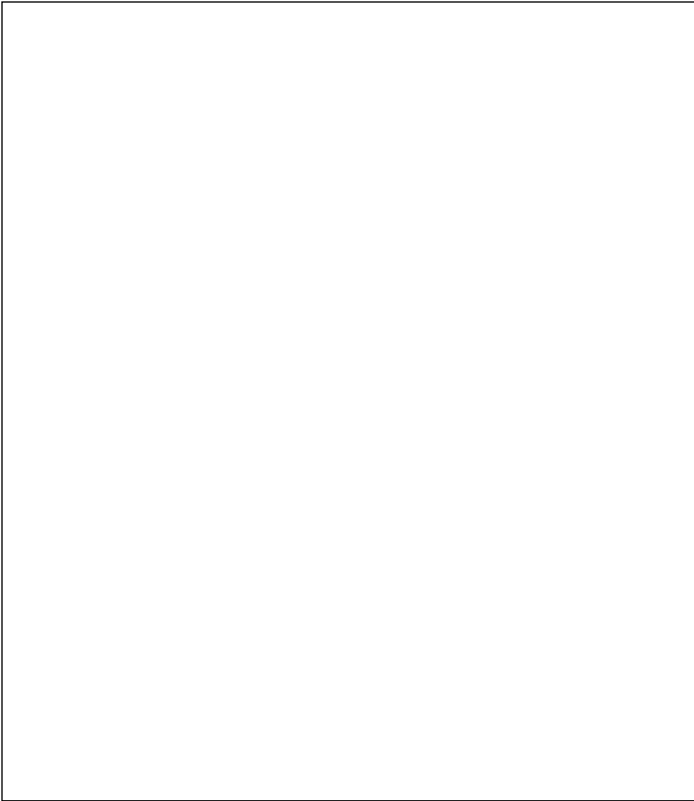


Caravaggio, **The Conversion on the Way to Damascus**, 1601

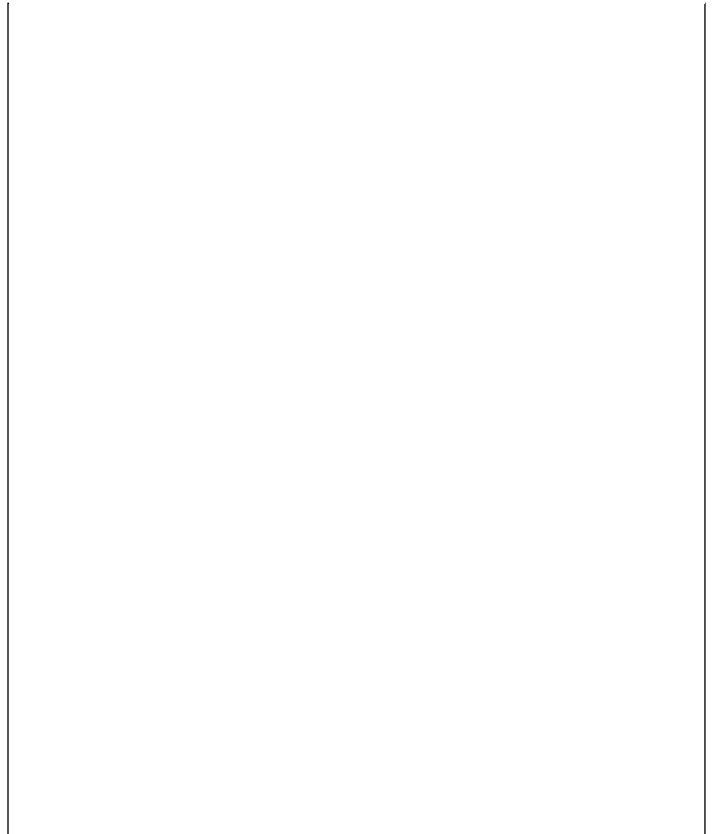

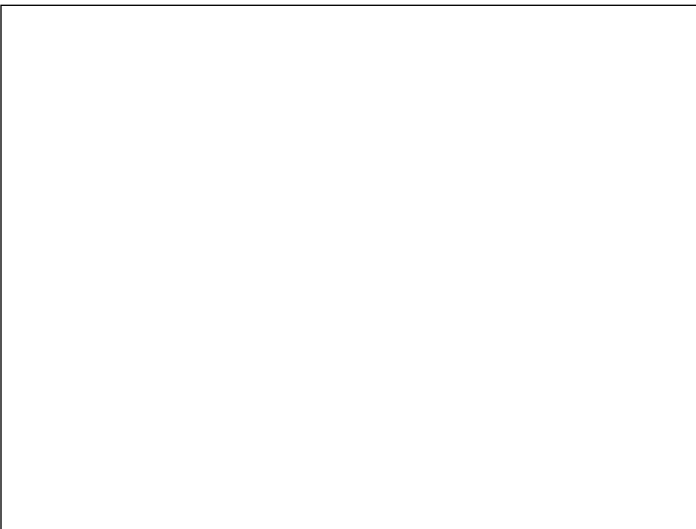

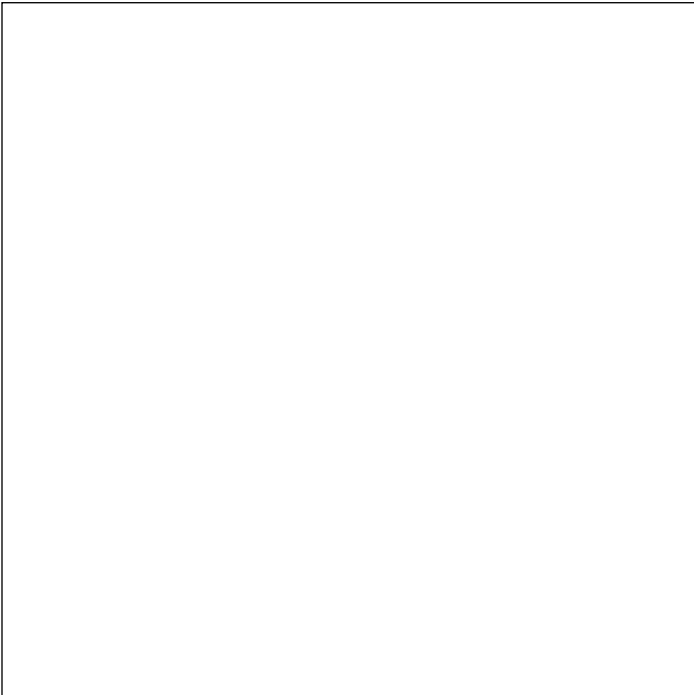
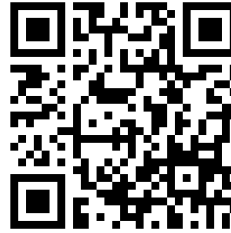


Seurat, **A Sunday Afternoon on the Island of La Grande Jatte**, 1884–1886

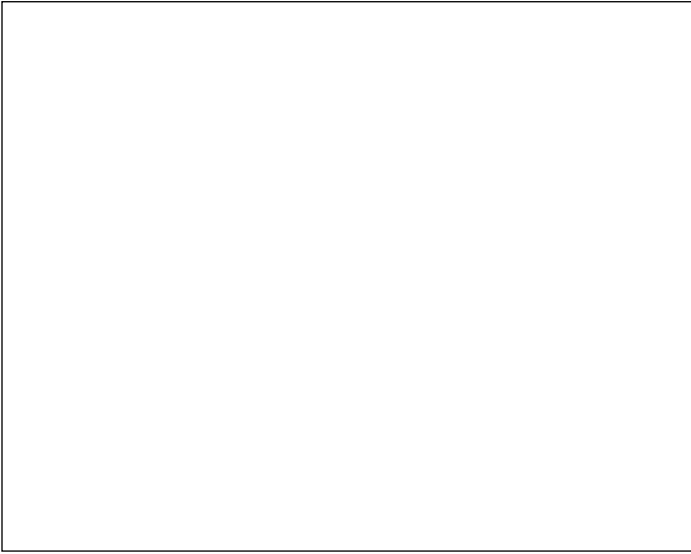


Claude Monet, **Water Lilies**, 1916

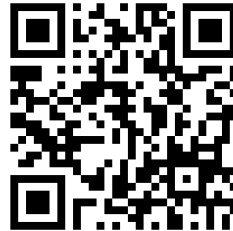

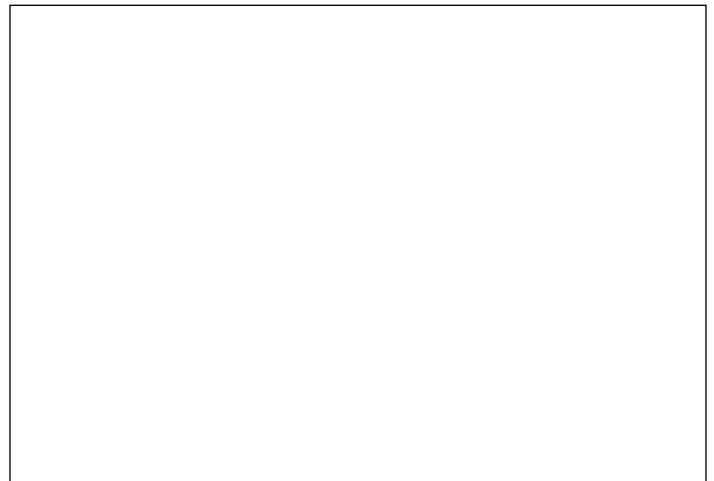


Vincent van Gogh, **The Starry Night**, 1889

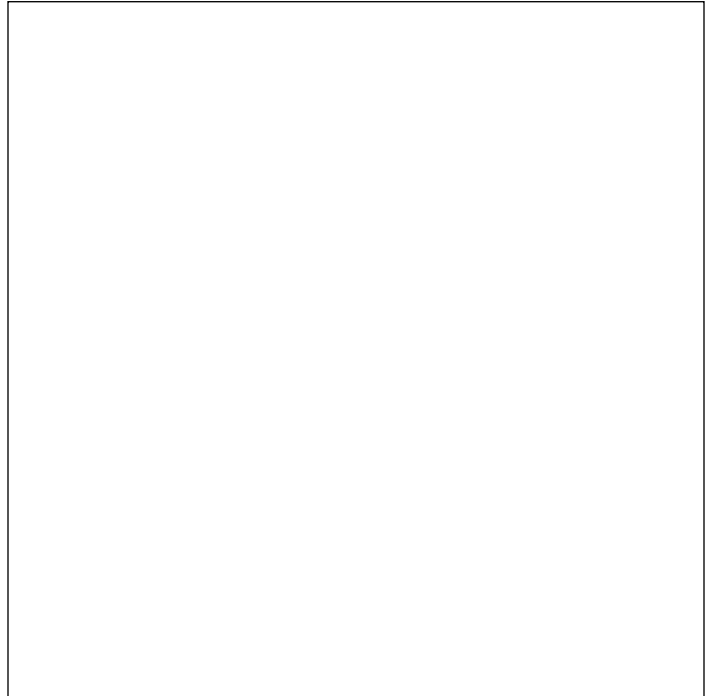

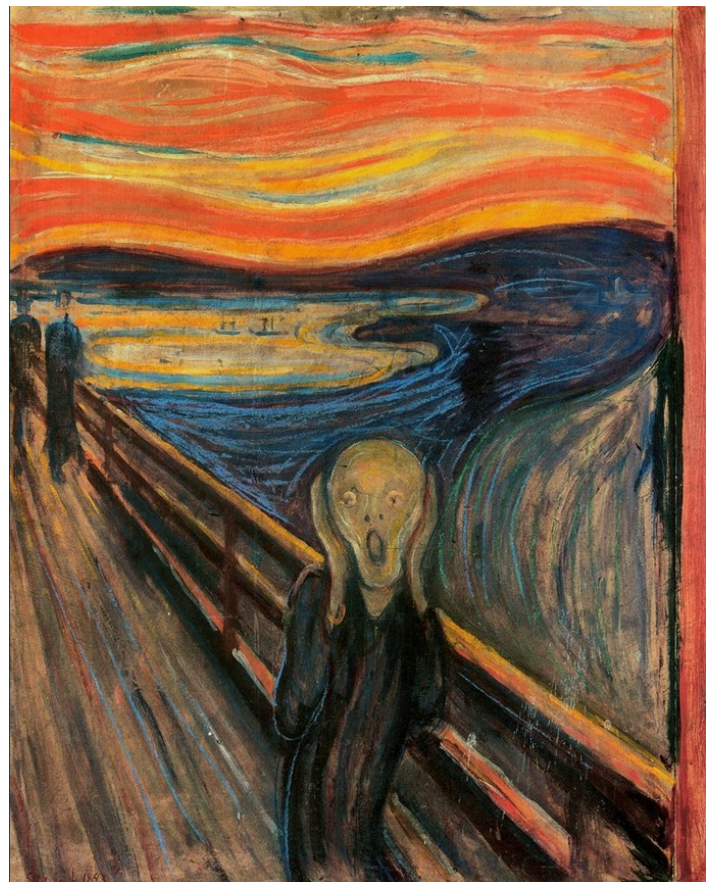

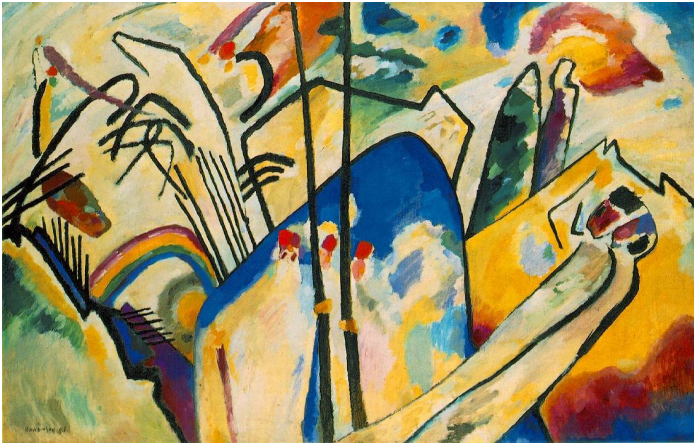


Edvard Munch, **Der Schrei der Natur (The Scream of Nature)**, 1893

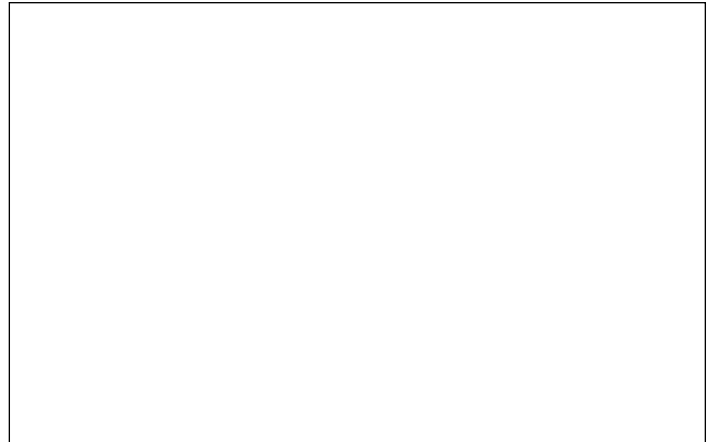

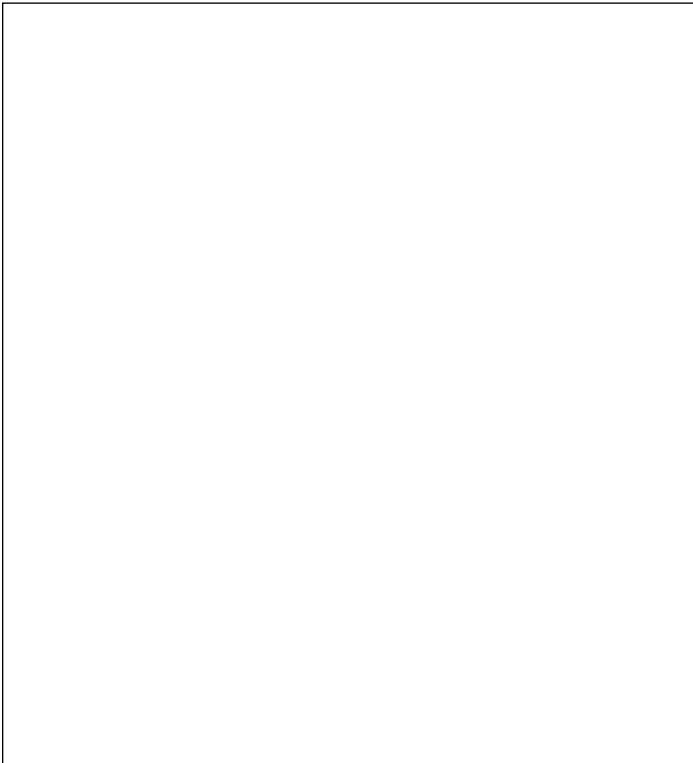
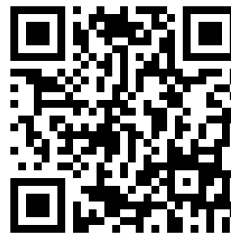


Wassily Kandinsky, **Composition IV**, 1911

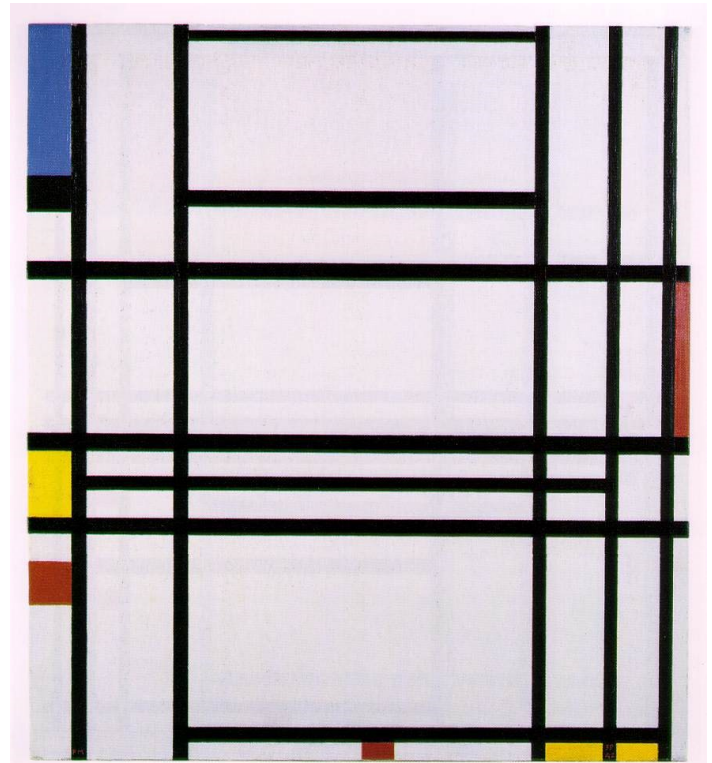

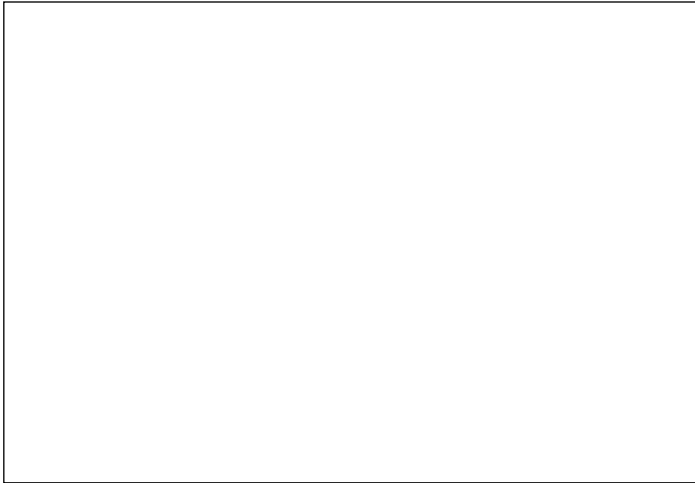


Piet Mondrian, **Composition No. 10**, 1939-42

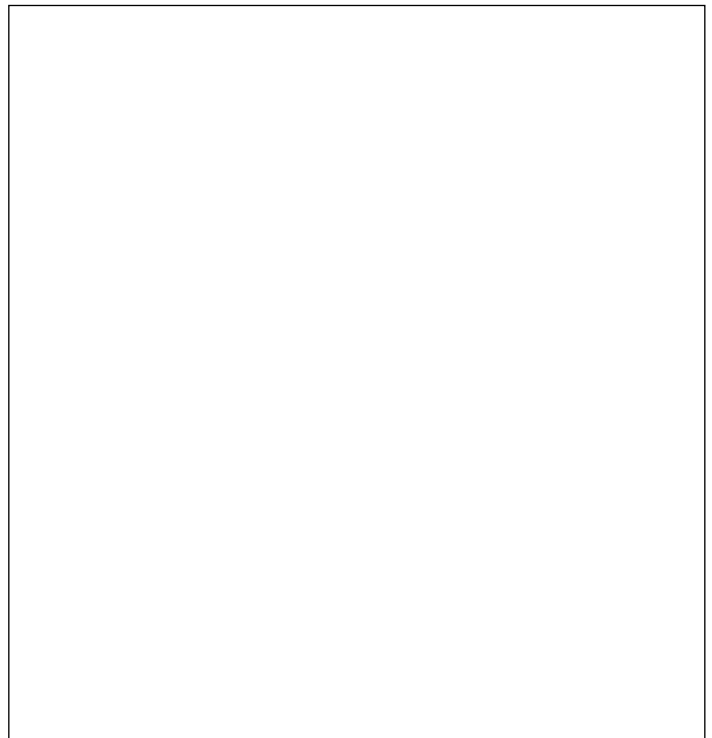

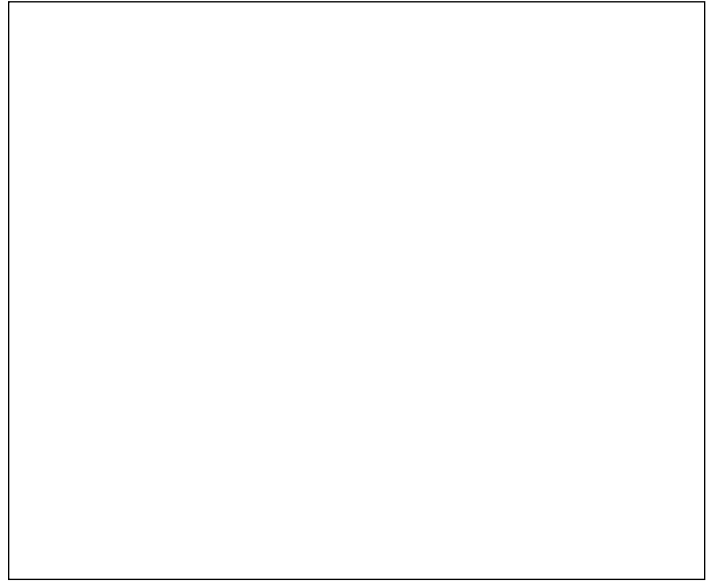

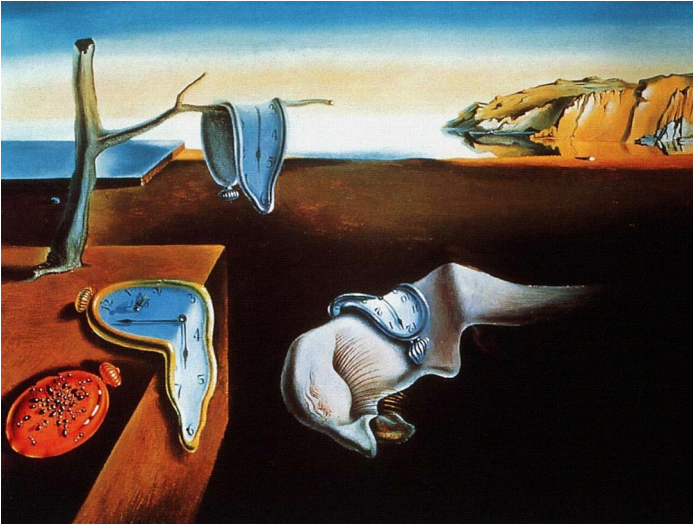


Pablo Picasso, **Guernica**, 1937

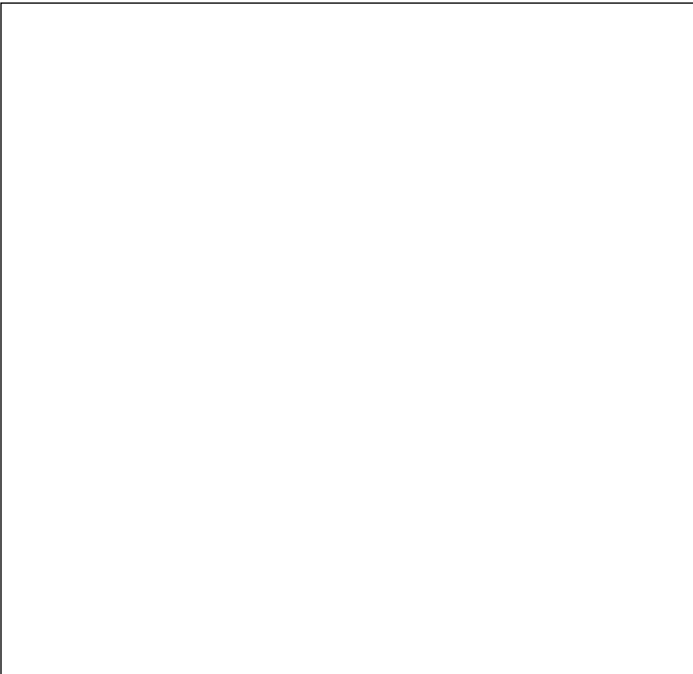


Salvador Dalí, **The Persistence of Memory**, 1931

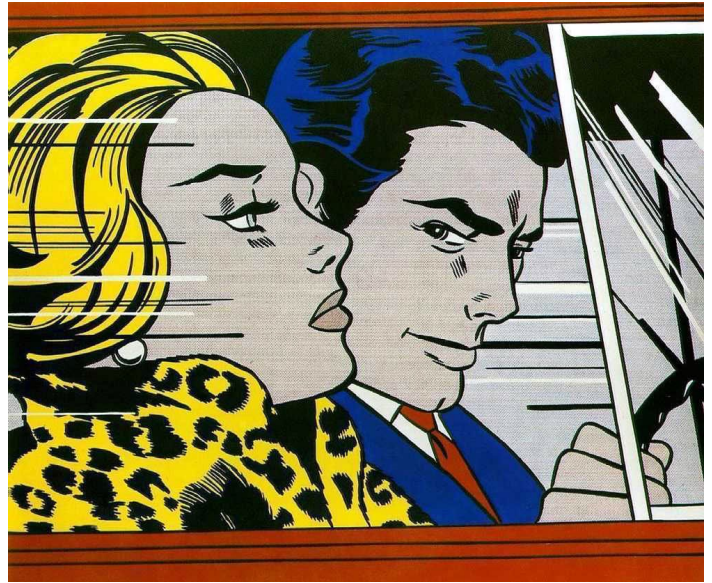

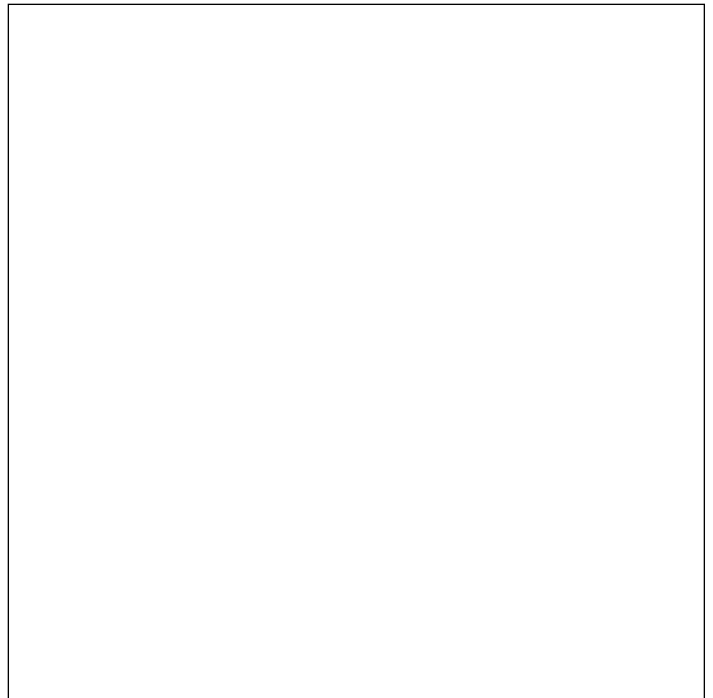
