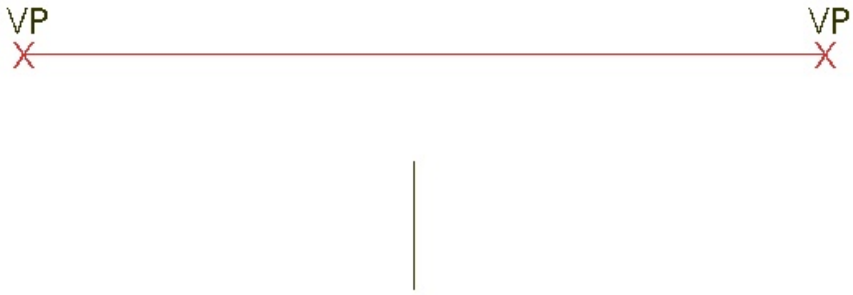
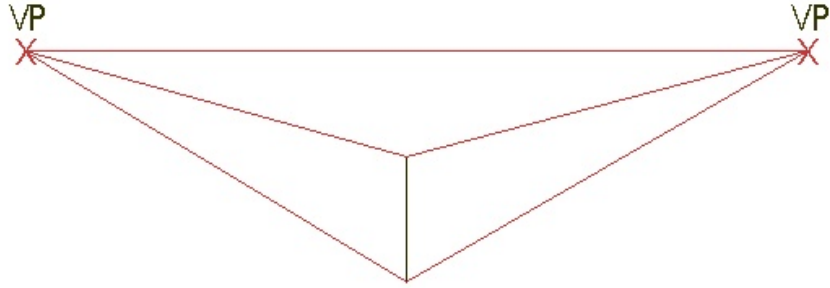


Two point perspective

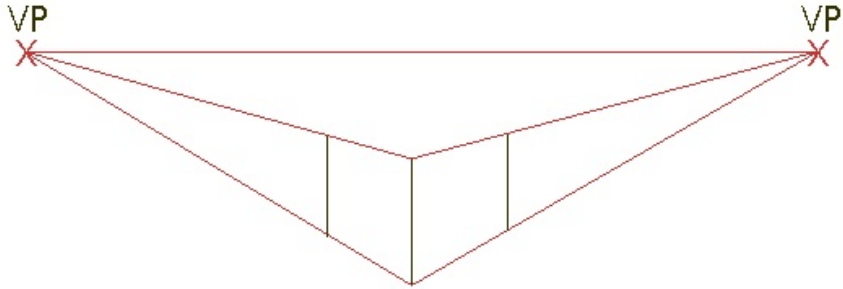
step one  
Draw a horizon line and choose two vanishing points. Then draw the front edge straight up and down.



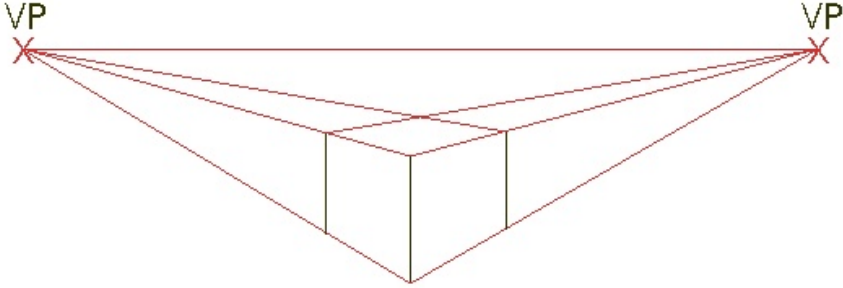
step two  
Draw the tops and bottoms of both sides heading toward each vanishing point.



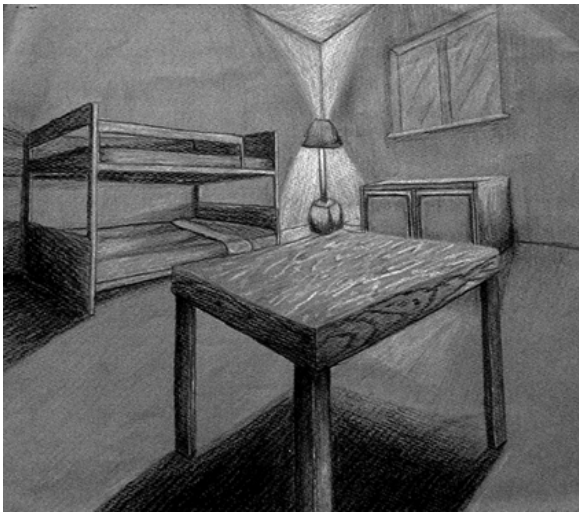
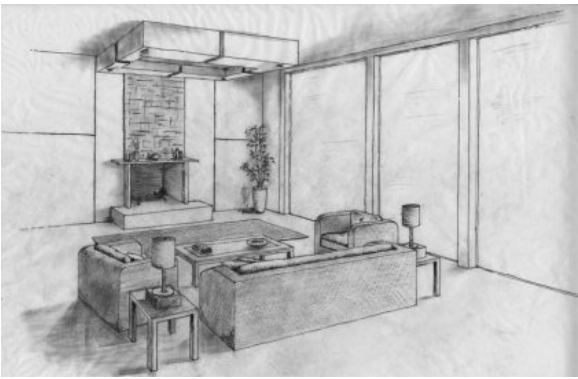
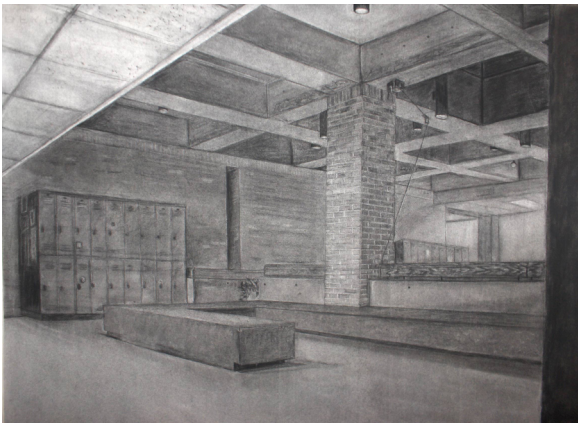
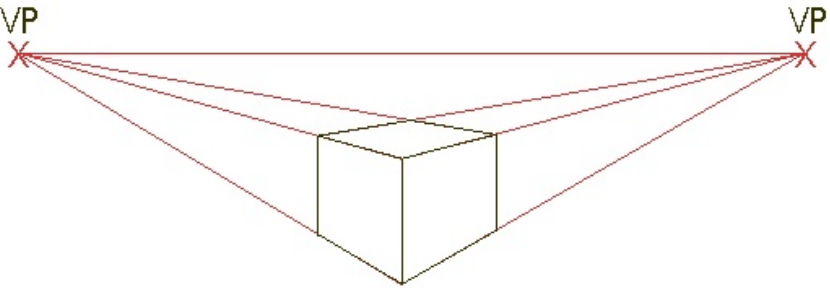
step three  
Draw vertical lines for the back of both sides.



step four  
To draw the top, draw lines to each vanishing point from the two top corners.

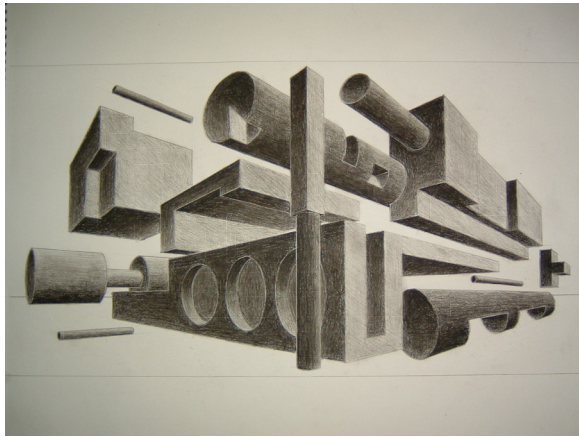


step five  
You are done! Try to keep your lines light to avoid outlines in your final drawing.



Create a two point perspective painting

**Perspective:** Use two point perspective correctly to create a sense of depth  
**Composition:** use a non-central composition with a colour scheme that only uses one half of the colour wheel  
**Painting:** Use carefully mixed colours applied in a smooth, even fashion  
**Colour to create depth:** use intensity and warm/cool colours to make things appear near and far
