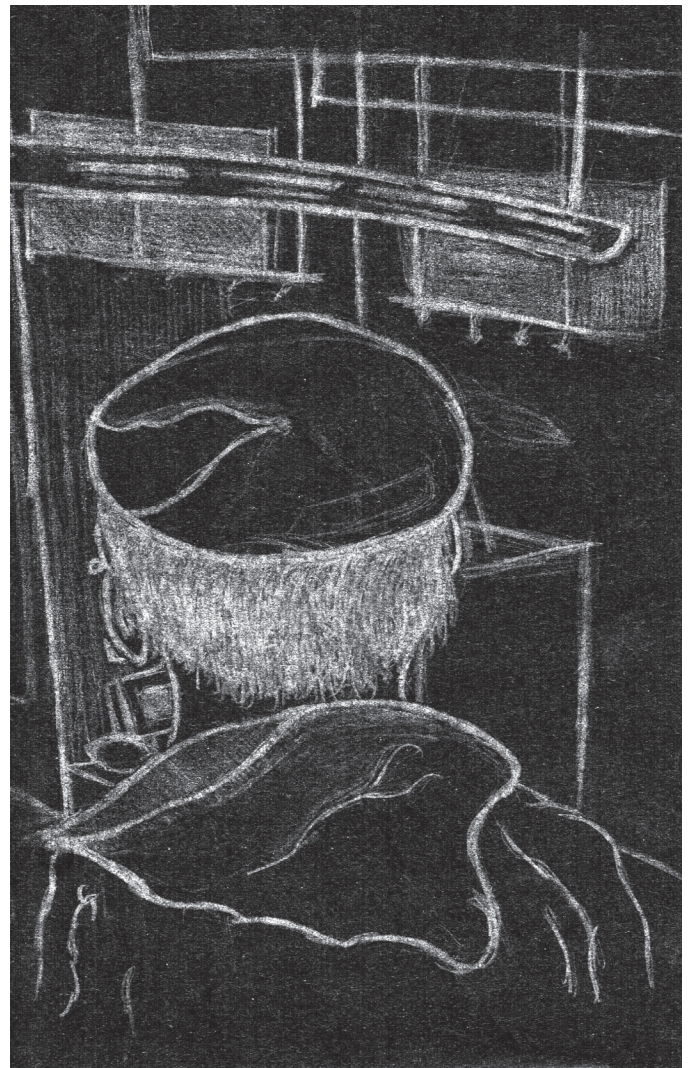
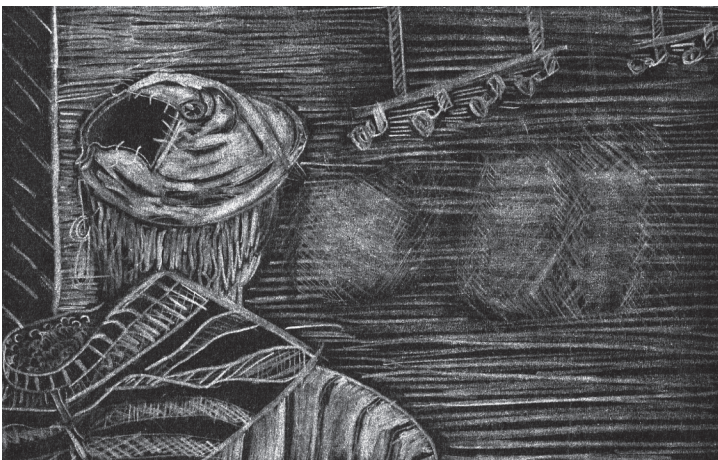


Skill builders Observed Textures
