How to do Drypoint Printmaking

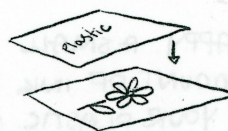
DRYPOINT PRINTING

MATERIALS

- GLOVES *
- THICK PAPER
CUT TO SIZE
- SPOON
- RECYCLED PLASTIC
- CHEESE CLOTH x2 pc
- AQUA INK
- WATER CONTAINER
- TISSUE PAPER
- SCRIBE/AWL
- NEWS PRINT

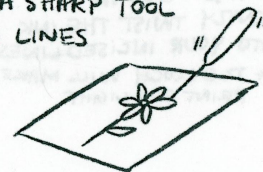

DRAW YOUR DESIGN ON PAPER. PLACE PLASTIC OVER DRAWING. TAPE DOWN FOR DRAWING EASE.

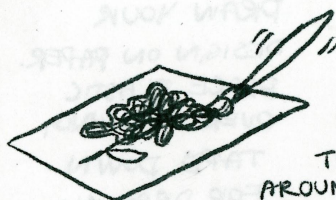


USING A SCRIBE OR AWL, TRACE THE IMAGE INTO THE PLASTIC. DOING THIS WITH A SHARP TOOL CREATES INCISED LINES WITH BURRS.



BEFORE INKING PLASTIC, ADD SEVERAL PIECES OF PAPER TO A BATH OF WARM WATER. SOAK 15min

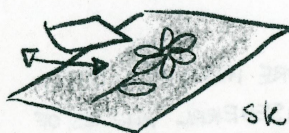
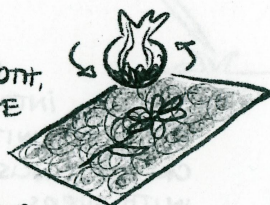

APPLY A SMALL AMOUNT OF INK TO YOUR PLASTIC. THEN PUSH IT AROUND UNTIL THE SURFACE IS COVERED.

MAKE A PILLOW BALL WITH YOUR CHEESE CLOTH, ONE WILL BE "DIRTY" THE OTHER "CLEAN" GENTLY TWIST THE INK INTO YOUR INCISED LINES.

* TOO MUCH WILL MAKE YOUR PRINT TOO LIGHT.

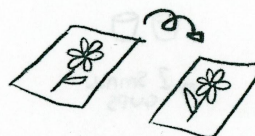


ONCE PLASTIC IS MOSTLY GREY, USE TISSUE PAPER TO SKIM THE SURFACE TO REMOVE A FINE LAYER OF INK.

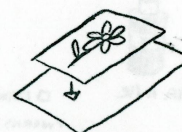
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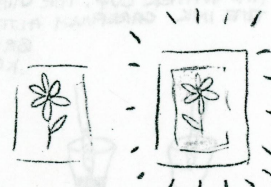
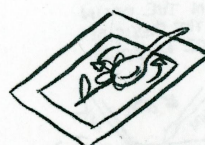
REMOVE A PIECE OF PAPER FROM WATER + PAT IT DRY ON NEWSPRINT.



FLIP PLASTIC OVER



AND PLACE INK SIDE DOWN ON DAMP PAPER



BURNISH PLASTIC WITH METAL SPOON, HEAVY PRESSURE, THEN REMOVE! YOU HAVE A PRINT!

How to do Paper Marbling

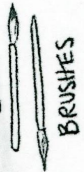
SUMINAGASHI (PAPER MARBLING)

MATERIALS

□ PRINTER PAPER



□ 2 POINTED BRUSHES



□ WATER TUB



□ INDIA INK

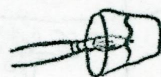


□ DAWN SOAP -
WORKS BEST



□ 2 SMALL CUPS

FILL YOUR WATER BASIN + SMALL CUPS AS DIRECTED BELOW. DIP THE TIP OF ONE BRUSH INTO THE WATER CUP. THE OTHER WILL BE USED IN THE INK. CAREFULLY ALTERNATE DIPPING THE BRUSHES IN THE BASIN KEEPING THE DESIGN IN THE MIDDLE

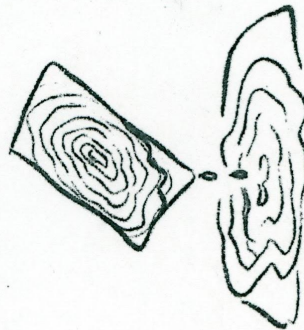
ONCE SATISFIED, GENTLY BLOW ON THE WATER SURFACE TO DISRUPT THE DESIGN.

LAY A PIECE OF PAPER ON THE WATER HOLD THE EDGES SO THEY DON'T CURLE.



ALLOW THE PAPER TO SOAK IN THE INK. ONCE YOU CAN SEE THE INK...

GRAB A CORNER AND PEEL THE PAPER OFF. ALLOW EXCESS WATER TO DRIP OFF. LAY FLAT TO DRY, OR PRESS BETWEEN PAPER TO DRY FLAT.



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
